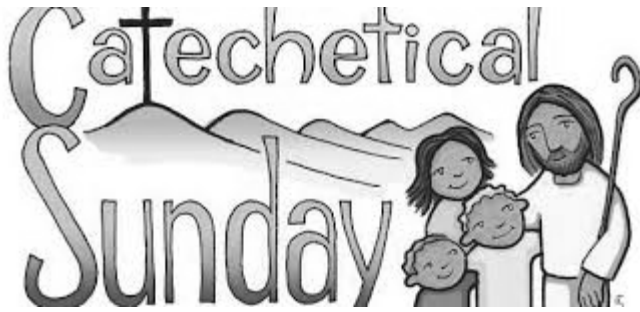

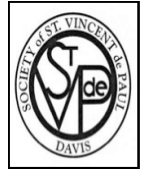

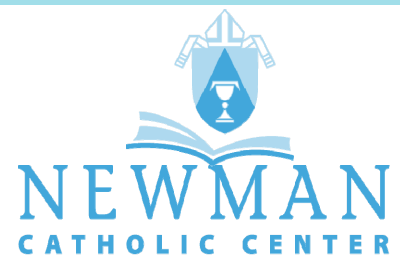

ST. JAMES SCHOOL— PARISH CONNECTION

Since we returned in August, St. James students have been focusing on the theological virtues of faith, hope, and charity, the roots of our virtue tree. We have also been focusing on what it means to be a FALCON using our school wide learning expectations (SLEs). As members of the St. James community, we are faith enhanced Catholics, academic learners, loving community members, creative learners, Olympian learners, and environmentally aware citizens.

Next, we will learn more about the four main trunks of the virtue tree that represent the cardinal virtues upon which all good habits hinge. The cardinal virtues are TEMPERANCE (self-control), FORTITUDE (courage), PRUDENCE (sound judgment), and JUSTICE (fairness). When we are open to the grace of God at work in us through the gifts of the Holy Spirit and virtues, we are able to flourish. The person fully alive in Christ is able to welcome others, sharing with them the riches he or she has received.

During the months of September and October, St. James School will focus on the cardinal virtue of temperance. Temperance can be represented by an olive wreath. In ancient times the olive wreath was the crown given to athletes and emperors. Temperance is often the fruit of hard work and gives the prize of authentic self-mastery. It crowns our decisions with a holy balance, joy, and inner peace. The virtues related to temperance are: honesty, humility, meekness, moderation, modesty, orderliness, and self-control.

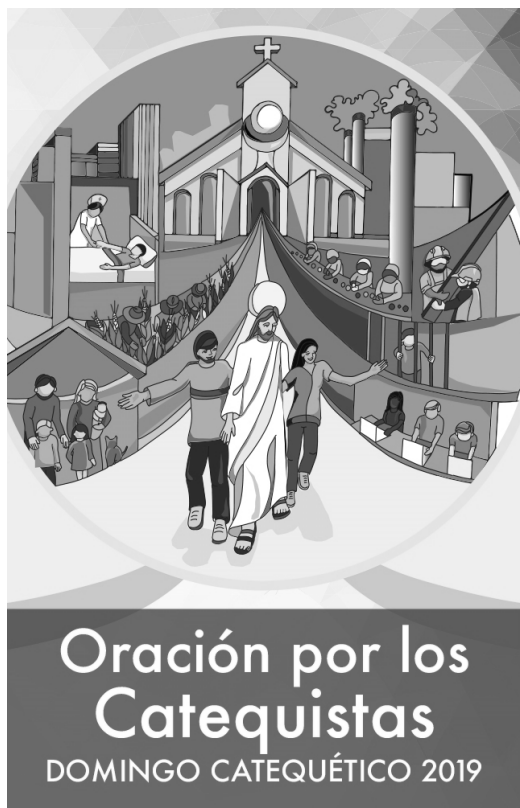
