March 21, 2021– Fifth Sunday of Lent



In the Gospel today, Jesus says “Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be. The Father will honor whoever serves me.” When we help the poor, we are truly followers of Jesus, servant of the poor.

In the Manual of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, we read, “If Jesus stands at the center of Vincentian spirituality, the poor stand next to him.” Jesus’ words, “you always will have the poor with you,” are the reason for Vincentian existence. Mercy is a facet of charity that calls us, first to identify in spirit with our suffering brothers and sisters. Mercy calls also for outward signs and actions. We weep with those who weep, rejoice with those who rejoice. We empathize; we reach out in compassion. Bishop Robert Barron sums up his idea of Christian charity this way: “From the outside, the Church’s charitable work might look a lot like social work. The difference is not only in the motivation but in the mystical animation. Behind the corporal and spiritual works of mercy is the reality of Christ continuing his work in and through his Mystical Body, the Church. Certainly, even an atheist of goodwill can serve the poor. But when a Christian serves the poor out of a deep sense of identity with Jesus Christ, the arms and eyes and hands of Jesus are mystically at work in the world.” let these words guide us during these last two weeks of Lent.

School-Parish Connection March 20-21, 2021

St. James School’s 2nd grade class has celebrated the Sacrament of First Reconciliation or Penance. Our 3rd through 8th graders also participated in Reconciliation during this Lenten season. Not only does the Sacrament of Penance free us from our sins, but it also challenges us to have the same kind of compassion and forgiveness for those who sin against us. We are liberated to be forgivers. We gain new insight into the words of the Prayer of St. Francis: “It is in pardoning that we are pardoned.” The Sacrament of Penance is God’s gift to us so that any sin committed after Baptism can be forgiven. Through our confession, we have the opportunity to repent and recover the grace of friendship with God. This Sacrament helps us stay close to the truth that we cannot live without God. “In Him we live and move and have our being” (Acts 17:28).

DIOCESAN CHRISM MASS

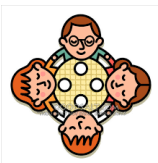
Bishop Jaime Soto will preside at the annual Chrism Mass on Tuesday, March 23, 2021 at 6pm.

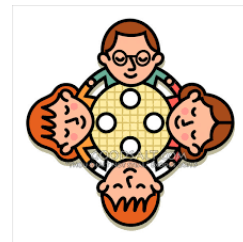
