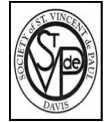

**The Vincentian Corner
July 12th — Fifteenth Sunday
in Ordinary Time**



Explaining the parable of the sower, Jesus says, “the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.”

Vincentians might well see themselves as sowers when they assist the needy, for through their actions, they are indeed spreading the word of Jesus. St. Vincent de Paul wrote, “Since Christ willed to be born poor, he chose for himself disciples who were poor. He made himself the servant of the poor and shared their poverty. He went so far as to say that he would consider every deed which either helps or harms the poor as done for or against himself. Since God surely loves the poor, he also loves those who love the poor. For when one person holds another dear, he also includes in his affection anyone who loves or serves the one he loves.” The economic crisis triggered by the Covid-19 outbreak has left many in our community on the very edge. Each week the SVdeP help line is flooded with calls from neighbors in need. But even as they are sheltered in their homes, St. James Vincentians continue the work of St. Vincent and Blessed Frederic Ozanam, reaching out by phone to provide support and aid to those in desperate need. Now that church doors are again open, we pray that our fellow parishioners will continue their generosity as the need increases throughout our neighborhoods.

MORE RANDOM THOUGHTS AND PRAYERS FROM DEACON SAM

--We belong to God – how excellent this is! We are each given the dignity of being a child of God, made in His image and likeness, We each have the responsibility to work for peace and justice – everyone deserves justice, I really believe that what is lasting in the world is our acts of love – God wants us, God encourages us to transform our world and make it holy by our life and our love – we pray for God to give us each the grace to see what we have to do and the strength and courage to do it.

--We are each called to be a living work of God by our words and actions. Jesus showed us how to live by His words and actions – I pray “Teach me your ways, O Lord.”

--Our value comes from the fact that God created us. We have each been wonderfully made. We are never a burden to God – we are His prized possessions! God longs to be good to us. Do we also long to be good – for Him?

--In this world, we can’t help everyone – but, we can help someone. It is amazing to see what it does to people when you show someone that you care. One of the most important things we can do in life is to put our love into action and help someone. We are each on a mission from God to help someone. Be amazed to see what happens when people actually feel they are seen and not invisible to others and needed, and that someone cares.

--Mother Teresa says that the pathway to God is “silence, prayer, love, service and peace.” Sounds right to me. How blessed and lucky we are when we desire God and not the passing possessions of this world.

--What catches the attention of the world is to see a life joyfully and authentically lived, a person who has found meaning in his/her life. We cannot stop life from happening to us but we can choose how to respond. God’s invitation to each of us is to get our minds out of ourselves and be a blessing to others.

--We do not overcome evil with evil – but, rather, with good. Anger weighs us down. We each have the ability to find what is good in people especially those with whom we are upset. None of us are perfectly made – we are all works in progress. Opposition does not determine who we are – it reveals who we each are. The whole of life should be oriented to seeing the face of Jesus – how different our world would be if we saw the face of Jesus in everyone!

--It is interesting that when someone gets outside of him or herself, that person can become someone else’s miracle. Many times, I believe the answer to our own prayers comes from helping someone else. When we reach out to others, healing comes.

--The line separating good from evil passes right through the human heart. Jesus asks us to imitate His humility – to be kind and generous to others and humble before God. I pray: “God, give me the courage to see things as you do.” If each of us can make a difference in one person’s life, then we know our life has meaning.

--Do we want to be saints? If not, why not? Holiness is a desire to please God in all things. It arises from our belief that God is in charge. God calls us all to holiness.

--Our words are important because they have the power to lift people – to heal people. No matter how gifted we each may be, we are all incomplete and need others. Be generous with compliments – a blessing is in the form of a gentle “hello”, a phone call, a note, etc. can let people know that you care. Ordinary words for us may be extraordinary for someone else. Don’t withhold healing words – everyone is going through something. One compliment can have an impact for a lifetime. Who can I bless and uplift today? this week? now?

--All of our life is meant to be lived for the glory of God. We can seek God in many places – we may eventually find Him in ourselves. “Dear God, I pray that I will hear you talk to me – even when you whisper.” Where is the treasure of our heart – power, material possessions, etc. “God help me to keep my mind and heart fixed on YOU as the center of my life. I pray that I may be a person of virtue, a person who serves the common good, so as to make the world a better place.”

--In my quiet moments I meditate on the sovereignty of God and the fact that nothing is impossible with God. I think that perseverance in prayer is a noble and critical virtue. Each of us should try hard to resist discouragement – especially when times are hard – and not give up on our prayer life. Just because in my weakness I might give up on something doesn’t also mean that God gives up on it. If our hearts are open, God gives us all the grace we need to see what we have to do and the strength to do it. Eternal life in heaven is certainly worth the struggle we experience in this life. “Dear God, strengthen my faith, my trust and my perseverance. They will be done – always. Thank you God. Amen.”
