Pope Francis' Five Finger Prayer



1. The thumb is the closest finger to you. So start praying for those who are closest to you. They are the persons easiest to remember. To pray for our dear ones is a "sweet obligation."
2. The next finger is the index. Pray for those who teach you, instruct you and heal you. They need the support and wisdom to show direction to others. Always keep them in your prayers.
3. The following finger is the tallest. It reminds us of our leaders, the governors and those who have authority. They need God's guidance.
4. The fourth finger is the ring finger. Even that it may surprise you, it is our weakest finger. It should remind us to pray for the weakest, the sick or those plagued by problems. They need your prayers.
5. And finally we have our smallest finger, the smallest of all. Your pinkie should remind you to pray for yourself. When you are done praying for the other four groups, you will be able to see your own needs but in the proper perspective, and also you will be able to pray for your own needs in a better way.

November 3, 2019—Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel we find that God is a God of the living, and this is indeed the core of our hope. Jesus has risen and is with us, therefore at no time should we be without hope for the future.



Often, hope is all the needy have, and all too frequently, the words 'poor' and 'hungry' are synonymous. Pope Francis has written, "Consumerism has accustomed us to waste, but throwing food away is like stealing it from the poor and hungry." The first Corporal Act of Mercy is to "Feed the Hungry," and as we approach Advent and the Season of Giving, let us consider the many ways the Lord gives us to feed those who are without food. On home visits, St. James Vincentian visitors always bring with them at least one bag of groceries as a sign of God's love. Next weekend, the St. James SVdeP Conference will be holding its last donation opportunity of the year, the annual Fall Food Offertory, asking Parishioners to contribute non-perishable food items such as a complete "dinner-in-a-bag" for a family of four. The time you spent with Him will deepen your connection with Him and make your soul more beautiful in heaven and bring peace on earth." Even if you can't always commit to an hour of Adoration, drop in!

Before Jesus crucifixion, in the Garden of Gethsemane, He asked His Apostles, "Could you not keep watch with me for one hour?" Spending one hour with Jesus became a tradition in the Church.
