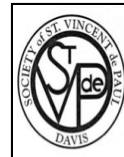

In today's Gospel, God demonstrates great love for us by sending his Son so that we may believe in him. We demonstrate our great love for God by doing good works: reaching out to others; acting in justice and charity.



The late German Catholic priest and theologian, Johann Baptist Metz (1928–2019), reminded us that, “The Christian is not only responsible for what he does or fails to do but also for what he allows to happen to others” And early in his pontificate, our Holy Father used his annual Lenten message to speak out against what he called the “globalization of indifference.” When we look at the world at large it is easy to see this indifference or lack of concern manifested in a wide-spread disregard for the homeless and even the invisible poor who are housed but struggle to make ends meet, especially during this time of economic chaos. Still, when we narrow our view to specific segments of society we are able to answer Pope Francis and Father Metz. We are not indifferent. Here at St. James, your generosity has enabled our Vincentian client aid teams to reach out a helping hand to those in need. Now as we face the conclusion of the moratorium on rent payments, we anticipate a huge upswing in requests for financial assistance, and as we offer our sincere thanksgiving for your support, we pray that you will continue to care for what happens to others by sharing your abundance in the face of their need.

FEAST OF FAITH

Lent, a Season of the Word

Each year on the First Sunday of Lent we hear one of the Gospel accounts of the temptation of Jesus. In Luke's account, the devil cites the scriptures repeatedly, urging Jesus to interpret them in a false, self-serving way—if God sends angels to protect those whom God loves (as it says in Psalm 91), then prove it! But Jesus resists this insidious temptation by turning to scripture passages that tell of right relationship with God—living by God's word, trusting in God, and worshiping God alone.

Jesus himself listened to the inspired word of God and let it shape and form him.

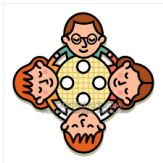
Through the liturgy, we do the same. The readings we hear at Mass can teach us, but that is not their primary function. Rather, the scriptures are meant to reveal the Lord to us, to let us experience his presence, and to form us in our Christian identity. Christ's presence is realized by his spoken word, “since it is he himself who speaks when the Holy Scriptures are read in the Church” (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, 7). In the readings proclaimed at Mass, we hear the voice of Christ himself.

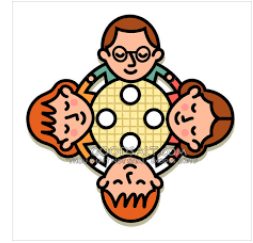
