ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

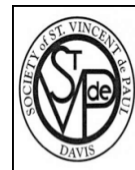

The Vincentian Corner October 20, 2019—Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time



*In the Gospel today
Jesus tells his disciples
to pray always without
becoming weary.,
indeed our prayer must
always be an expression of our love for
God, our family, our world, and
especially for the suffering poor.*

St. Vincent de Paul (1581-1660) teaches us that, "Outpourings of affection for God, of resting in his presence, of good feelings toward everyone – sentiments and prayers like these are suspect if they do not express themselves in practical love which has real effects." Prayer is an important component of each Vincentian home visit. The visiting team prays before entering the client's home. At the end of the visit, the team asks the client if he or she would like to join them in prayer – or even lead the prayer. These prayers and these visits help us discern the needs of those who call for assistance. Each of our meetings begins and ends with a prayer which, in essence, makes of the entire gathering a protracted prayer. Finally, St. James Vincentians also give thanks regularly for our fellow parishioners and the generous support they provide to help make our work possible.
